Dear Parent / Carer,

We would like to invite the parents/carers of the Year 13 students who are in our World of Work tutorial groups to attend our information evening on **Tuesday 15 February 2022**. The evening will enable parents/carers to gain information to support students who are seeking apprenticeships or employment when they leave college.

The evening will start at **6:30pm** in the **main hall** at Elliott Hudson College, White Rose Office Park, Millshaw Park Lane, Leeds LS11 0LT, with refreshments being available from **6:00pm**. The evening will end at **7:30pm**.

In the presentation we will cover information about apprenticeships and where to find them, an insight into the labour market in the Leeds City Region including the sectors that are thriving locally, the advice available in college and how parents and carers can support students with their next steps.

Following the talks, there will be a brief time for students and parents/carers to chat to the careers staff who work with our World of Work students.

Measures in place to mitigate the risk of coronavirus:

From 27 January 2022, it is no longer mandatory for certain high-risk events and venues to check the COVID-19 status of attendees. However, venues where people are in close contact may choose to continue to check the COVID-19 status of attendees and their workforce to keep everyone safer. In order to continue to protect our college community, all over 18s will be asked to provide evidence of their vaccine status or a negative lateral flow test before entering the college. The following will be accepted:

- A Covid pass on the NHS app (preferred).
- An email with a negative lateral flow or PCR test within 24 hours of the event.
- A vaccination card showing the date of vaccines or proof that you are exempt from vaccination on the basis of a medical exemption or you have taken part in a clinical trial for a COVID-19 vaccine.

Please also ensure that you do not attend the event if you are experiencing any Covid related symptoms or are awaiting the results of a PCR test.

Entry into college will be quicker if you have a Covid pass. Get your NHS Covid pass through the NHS app and present the QR code which can be quickly scanned by staff in college.
